Job Title: Equine Therapist or PATH certified Equine Therapist

Hours: Seasonal, part-time employee, mainly on weekends

Rate of Pay: Equine Therapist receive \$200 per Horsey House Call

**Overview of Position:** The Equine Therapist is responsible for executing safe and effective Horsey House Calls and managing all horse-related elements of the Horsey House Call day. The candidate must be comfortable being in charge of seasonal staff, the horse, volunteers and any participants during the Horsey House Call visit.

## Qualifications:

- Completes Camp Casey's online volunteer training
- Must have reliable transportation
- Must be 18 years or older with valid driver's license
- Must have availability to lead a minimum of 4 weekend Horsey House Calls
- Horse experience is required (can accommodate emergency situations, comfortable loading/unloading a rider, loading/unloading horse from trailer, and able to assess equine needs)
- Confident to guide a group of children through a scheduled day
- Outgoing personality, engaging and good with children
- Ability to properly time manage/task manage
- Must be comfortable with public speaking and able to lead a crowd
- Be in good physical health and able to stand for at least three hours, often in hot weather and direct sun

## Function:

- Coordinates and executes safe and effective Horsey House Calls
- Sees to the safety and well-being of the Hero Herd Horse
- Sees to the maintenance and inventory of supplies and equipment (report needs to Supervisor)
- Oversees Ranch Hand and Activity Leader during Horsey House Call
- Facilitates riding order by review of completed waiver's collected for each participant
- Follows guidelines for social media/photo protocol
- Adhere to COVID-19 protocol and guidelines for staff and participants

## Major Accountabilities:

- 1. Horse Management
  - Oversees the safety and care of Camp Casey's Hero Herd horse
  - Assists with evaluating the Hero Herd horse's health and safety concerns
- 2. Supplies and Equipment
  - Cares for horse tack and equipment
  - Collects inventory from Activity Leader after Horsey House Call visit
  - Collects inventory of equine supplies from Ranch Hand after each Horsey House Call visit
- 3. Certification
  - Stays current with CPR/First Aid certification and provides proof to supervisor
  - Stays current with PATH certification (when applicable)
- 4. Horsey House Calls
  - Plans ahead and completes safe and effective Horsey House Call visit
  - Maintains and submits organized documentation of the day to Supervisor via the mobile office/clipboard
