One of Camp Casey's programs, Horsey House Calls, delivers "horse camp" to the homes of children who are often too sick to attend regular summer camp. We knock on the door and surprise the camper with a horse at their home for an afternoon filled with fun!

Overview of Position:

The programming intern is a competitive role and best suited for self-starting, creative, hard-working, passionate college professionals looking to gain invaluable, hands-on experience in the fields of (but not limited to): nonprofit operations, administration, resource management, community outreach and program development. The Program Intern will gain experience and skills in relationship building, planning and organization.
