Hours: Seasonal, part-time employee, mainly on weekends

Rate of Pay: Once all training is completed, the Ranch Hand receives \$75 per Horsey House Call

Overview of Position: The Ranch Hand is responsible for assisting the Equine Therapist in every way necessary to execute safe and effective Horsey House Calls and manage all horse-related elements of the Horsey House Call day. The Candidate must be comfortable around horses and capable of handling and securing the horse in an emergency situation.

Qualifications

- Completes Camp Casey's online volunteer training
- Must have reliable transportation
- Must be 16 years or older with valid driver's license
- Must have availability to lead a minimum of 4 weekend Horsey House Calls
- Horse experience is required (helping with loading/unloading horse from trailer, leading a horse, assisting with emergency protocol)
- Stays current with CPR/First Aid certification and provides proof to supervisor
- Outgoing personality, engaging and good with children
- Ability to properly time manage
- Be in good physical health and able to stand for at least three hours, often in hot weather and direct sun

Function

Works with the Equine Therapist to:

- Coordinate and execute safe, effective Horsey House Calls
- See to the safety and well-being of the Hero Herd Horse
- See to the maintenance and inventory of tack/supplies (Camp Casey's or Hero Herd owner's)
- Leads and oversees horse during Horsey House Call per Equine Therapists instructions
- Follows guidelines for social media/photo protocol
- Adhere to COVID-19 protocol and guidelines for staff and participants

Major Functions/Accountabilities

1. Horsey House Calls

- Meets and drives with Equine Therapist at Camp Casey truck/trailer
- Assists Equine Therapist with picking up and dropping off Hero Herd Horse
- Works with the Equine Therapist to perform safe and effective Horsey House Calls
- Helps the Equine Therapist manage important documents/paperwork
- Communicates with On-Call Assistant during designated contact points
